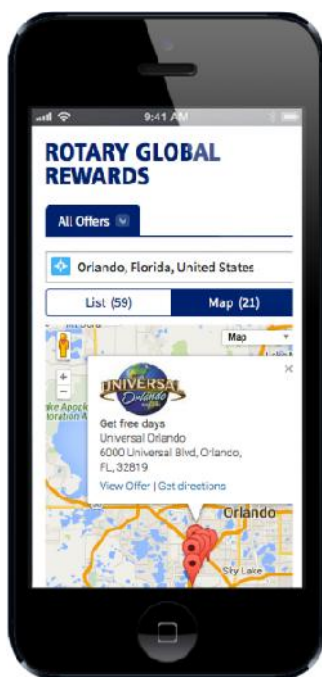

The Rotary Multi District Training Institute is made up of Rotary Districts in Arkansas, Texas, Oklahoma and Louisiana. RMDTI

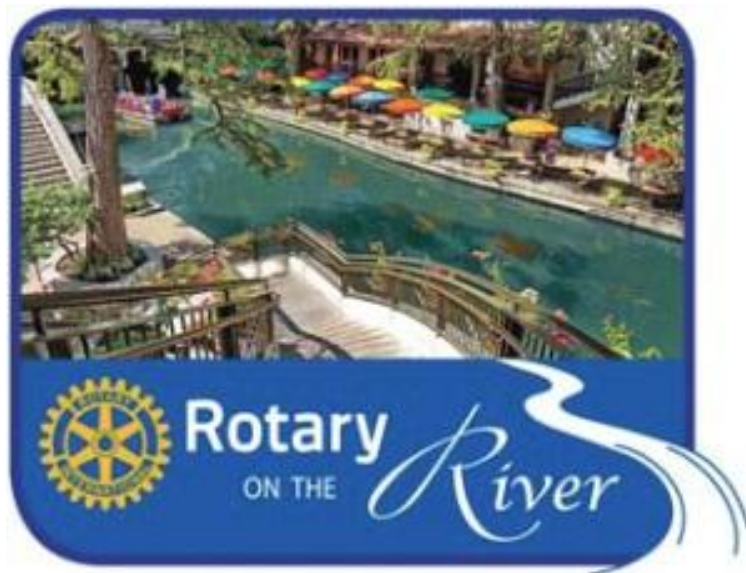

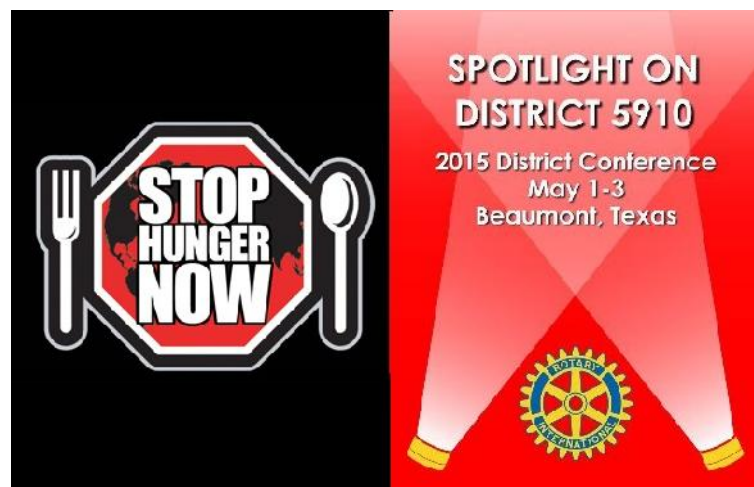

Three of these will be funded by the Texas City Rotary Foundation and one will be funded equally by the Texas City Rotary Foundation and a donation from Dr. Stephen Hale in honor of the late club member Dr. John Acree.

Rachel Huskey, Kolbi Darden, Shelby Gonzales, Stephanie Sharp, Ian Lovjoy and Sara Hodges will each receive \$2,000 for the next year funding of their original \$10,000 Rotary/Frank Webb award. This program got kick started five years ago and has grown to be the Club's proud and most significant local community service contribution. The goal is to make a difference. Two recipients have now received four year degrees and to date there has not been a single drop out.
